Armada PAL Camp: COVID 19 Response Memo

Dear PAL Camp Families,

Camp is almost here, and we couldn't be more excited. Plans are being finalized, water balloons are being purchased by the hundreds, and we are looking forward to what looks to be one of our best camp programs yet!

We want to reach out and inform you of the Armada Police Athletic League's Best Practices Covid-19 Protocols and Procedures. It has been a challenge keeping up with the latest requirements from the state and local health authorities. However, barring any last-minute changes from these entities, we will be taking the following steps to keep our campers and staff safe:

- Each camper and staff member will be asked a few easy screening questions and have their temperature checked upon arrival before boarding the bus.
- Masks will be worn while on the bus to and from camp as public transportation mask usage is still required.
- Campers will travel and spend time in cohorts to reduce quarantining, should that need arise.
- Mask wearing will not be required of campers while in their cabin or traveling within their cabin cohort group.
- Mask wearing will be required in all in-door settings where social distancing is not possible. Campers may remove their mask to eat and drink.
- Parents and local health authorities will be notified of any suspected illness, per our state-mandated COVID-19 Response Plan.
- In addition, all housing units and common areas will be cleaned, sanitized, and disinfected by our host camp before campers arrive and throughout the camp week.
- Hand sanitation stations will be available throughout the camp.
